The Maine Department of Transportation is currently estimating a highway preservation project on Route 2 in the Towns of Wilton - Farmington for advertisement of the subject project for competitive bids on April 06, 2016. Construction is scheduled for the summer of 2016.

The project is further described as follows: Beginning at mile point 58.43 on US Rte 2 just east of the intersection of Rte 156, extending easterly for 6.69 miles ending at Center Bridge #2146.

After the new pavement is placed, no permit to open this segment of highway will be granted for a period of three (3) years except as provided in Title 23, M.R.S.A. §3352. The purpose of this letter is to make the necessary notifications of the project to abutters, municipal officials and occupants of the highway under the provisions of 23 M.R.S.A. § 3351.
