COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Farmington Police Department will conduct a multi-agency active shooter training on Thursday, June 27 and Friday, June 28 from 08:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at Mount Blue High School in Farmington.

To avoid any confusion during this time, Farmington Police is notifying the community ahead of time. This exercise is closed to the general public for safety reasons. A concentration of emergency vehicles will be in the area of Mount Blue High School during that time. We hope this notification will alleviate any concerns. There will be no change in law enforcement coverage as a result of this event.

This training is a collaboration of Farmington Police, Franklin County Sheriff's Office, University of Maine at Farmington Police, Wilton Police, Jay Police, Maine Warden Service, US Border Patrol, Farmington Fire Department, Farmington Public Works Department.

The focus of this training event is three-fold. First, to bring together local law enforcement partners and enhance readiness in the advancement of community safety. Second, to increase the skill level of our individual officers in preparation for the worst-case scenario. Third, serve as a building block toward a more expansive training event for all regional first responders in the coming year.

Loud noise associated with the training event can be expected in the vicinity of the High School. Any emergency vehicles displaying emergency lights and/or siren away from the campus are not involved and are likely responding to real events.
